

**ORDINANCE 2018-3**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF BRADLEY BEACH, COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED TWENTY THREE, ARTICLE ONE, SECTION EIGHT H, BEACH FRONT AND ADJACENT WATERS RULES AND REGULATIONS.**

123-8H Animals. Except as specifically set forth herein, no person owning, keeping or harboring any animal shall permit it to be on the boardwalk, the promenade, the walkway, or any public land located east of the sidewalk area on Ocean Avenue. However, from October 1st to May 15th, it shall be lawful to allow dogs and other domestic animals to be on the public beach area in the Borough. During this period, the dogs or other domestic animals may be unleashed at the beach but must be accompanied by the owner or the owner's representative. Any such animals must be taken directly onto the public beach area. During the applicable time period, solely for the purpose of gaining access to the public beach area, it shall be lawful for said animals to cross over the boardwalk, promenade, walkway, and public area. The prohibitions contained in this subsection shall not apply to Seeing Eye dogs, guide dogs, or other guide animals.

This ordinance shall take effect on its final passage and publication according as provided by law.
