RESOLUTION 2014-
Authorizes a Shared Services Agreement with the City of Asbury Park for
Public Works Related Goods and Services

Mayor Engelstad offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Borough of Bradley Beach and the City of Asbury Park that it is advisable and mutually beneficial to the constituents of both municipalities to enter into a shared services agreement between the Borough of Bradley Beach and the City of Asbury Park for the provision of Public Works Related Goods and Services between them; and

WHEREAS, shared services are permitted under the Uniform Shared Services Consolidation Act, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, both municipalities have mutually agreed upon the attached form of a shared services agreement between them for the aforesaid purpose; and

WHEREAS, the agreement shall become effective as of October 15, 2014, conditioned upon the passage of a similar supporting resolution by the City of Asbury Park Governing Body at its regular meeting scheduled on or prior to said date; and shall remain in effect until such time as either one of the parties informs the other in writing of their intention to sever the agreement as of a mutually agreed upon date; and

WHEREAS, the executed form of said agreement by all parties will be submitted to the New Jersey State Division of Local Government Services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Bradley Beach as follows:

1. That a Shared Services Agreement for the provision of Public Works related Goods and Services between the Borough of Bradley Beach and the City of Asbury Park be and is hereby approved.
2. That all relevant Borough officials are hereby authorized and directed to undertake all actions that are necessary in order to effectuate the intentions of this Resolution.
3. That certified copies of this Resolution be provided to the Administrator, Auditor and the Public Works Superintendent.
