**RESOLUTION STAYING ENFORCEMENT OF VIOLATION NOTICES

WHEREAS, the Borough seeks to find a solution to the issue of hazardous shade trees without burdening residents with the costs of remediation and removal;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Bradley Beach, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, hereby stay enforcement of violation notices for shade tree violations until such time as the Mayor & Council are able to review and evaluate the issue and potential solution(s);

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Borough Administrator and Code Enforcement Officer.
