WHEREAS, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 17:27-3.3, each public agency shall notify the State of New Jersey, Department of the Treasury, Division of Purchase & Property, Contract Compliance Audit Unit, EEO Monitoring Program of its designation by January 10th of each year;

WHEREAS, the Borough wishes to designate Michele Whille, Deputy Clerk, to serve as its Public Agency Compliance Officer for the calendar year 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Governing Body of the Borough of Bradley Beach that Michele Whille, Deputy Clerk hereby designated to serve as its Public Agency Compliance Officer for the calendar year 2023.
