PROPANE GRILLS & COOKING DEVICES

The Uniform Fire Code adopted under N.J.A.C. 5:70-3, et seq., is hereby supplemented by the following provisions:

1. Open flame cooking devices, including but not limited to barbecue grills, charcoal grills, hibachi grills, outdoor fire places and fire pits, shall not be stored or used on any combustible porch, balcony, deck or other similar portion of a building or under any building overhang.

Exceptions:

- a) Detached one and two-family residential structures.
- b) Where buildings, balconies and decks are protected by an automatic sprinkler system.
- 2. There shall be no storage of liquefied-petroleum-gas fueled, or any other fuel on any porch, balcony, deck or other similar portion of a building, within any room or space of a building, within five (5) feet vertically or horizontally of an opening in any wall
- 3. Portable LP-gas cooking equipment, including those specifically listed above (1), shall not be used within any room or space of a building, within five (5) feet of any combustible exterior wall, or within five (5) feet of any combustible exterior wall, or within five (5) feet vertically or horizontally of an opening in any wall.

Exceptions:

a) Detached one and two-family residential structures.

Penalty for violations. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of the code or failing to comply with any order issued pursuant to any section thereof, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine not exceeding one thousand dollars, (\$1,000) or by imprisonment in the County Jail for not exceeding ninety (90) days or any combination of the above.
