 - a. Maritime Forest
 - i. Moving forward; bought fence; should be coming by end of month
 - 1. 625 linear feet around interior of forest and delineate lookout area
 - ii. New signage "Julie Schrek Maritime Forest"
 - iii. Educational sign for plants
 - iv. Marine timber bench on 6x6 posts
 - v. Shells
 - vi. May 17th (week of) USFWS and Borough officials at press event for dedicating forest as Julie Schrek Forest
 - 1. Will likely plant bayberry and grasses in bare patches
 - 2. Al will nail down date by early next week
 - vii. Goal is before Memorial Day
 - b. Sylvan Lake
 - i. Wetland benches
 - ii. Dredging
 - iii. Treatment wetland
 - iv. Bioswales
 - v. Will likely receive planning grant (\$50,000)
 - 1. Through DOD (REPI grant, through Navy)
 - a. Focused on sea-level rise resilience
 - b. Navy Base Earle
 - i. Also focuses on service members' communities, access to clean drinking water, transportation to work, etc.
 - 2. Hoping to match through NJ state funding to bring up to \$75,000 for planning and prelim studies
 - 3. Next will be an implementation grant to construct the forest
 - c. New project
 - i. Met with Kim Baker on Shade Tree Commission and would like to be a member of the Environmental Commission
 - ii. Discussion with Capt. Al about project to repurpose grass strip on Ocean and 2nd Aves to mimic a natural inland dune and swale system
 - d. Living Shoreline on Sylvan Lake from 2020

- i. Needs to be revisited
 - 1. Possible re-orientation of the shoreline
- 4.) Old Business
 - a. BB Strategic Planning Commitments Update how are we doing? Need help?
 - i. Environmental Resource inventory (due June)
 - 1. No record of last inventory
 - a. >15 years ago
 - 2. Possibly hire consultants to perform a comprehensive analysis (ANJEC)
 - a. Compilation of text, tables, and maps of environmentally significant features, natural resources, etc.
 - b. Possibly fund through resiliency planning grant or something similar
 - 3. Samples on ANJEC site; can use as template
 - 4. Was a recommendation from Master Plan
 - 5. Directive from Strategic Planning Committee
 - 6. Perhaps we should double back with Paula to determine what they wanted from their directive
 - a. Will it help the town receive grants?
 - i. Probably
 - b. Provides a basis for conservation of resources
 - 7. Due in June are our strategic plan on how we're going to complete it (not necessarily the full report)
 - ii. Lake Stability and Standards report (due June)
 - 1. Possible for Al to take lead on this? (Dan is currently lead but happy to stay on)
 - 2. Dan reached out to "Friends of Sylvan Lake" Facebook page, but hasn't heard back
 - 3. We can reach out to Councilman Gubitosi, who is liaison w/ Sylvan Lake Commission
 - iii. Community Gardens (due June) Meredith and Liz
 - 1. Environmental Club at BBES along with staff and administration to help plant community garden with list of crops by season
 - 2. School has a greenhouse (received through a grant)
 - a. Greenhouse hasn't been constructed yet
 - 3. We can help them revamp community garden
 - 4. Plan to leverage beds already in place in school, get community buy-in
 - 5. Phase 1
 - a. Educational food garden
 - 6. Phase 2
 - a. Community garden for next year; Environmental Commission would partner with food pantry, BBBCA, BBES Green Team
 - i. Possible locations
 - 1. Riley Park
 - 2. North end park (Lake Ave)

- a. Drawback is removing open space for recreation
 - Users/neighbors of park will be consulted
- 3. St. James Episcopal Church where food pantry is housed
 - a. Drawback: unclear who would pay for the water supply (Church?)
- 7. Possibility to have subsidized program for low-income families to have space to grow food
- 8. Idea is to have spaces rented out
- 9. This plan is still in preliminary stages
- 10. Legal issues? Insurance? Cost of water/construction? Water availability? DPW maintain watering schedule? Etc.
- iv. % of Shade Tree Coverage: will recommend the Shade Tree Commission take on this project
 - 1. Possibly run an algorithm to do this?
 - 2. Arye will dig into this and circle back
- b. Update on Recycle Coach can we add plastic film collection days (Liz) it isn't
 - i. Let's add the plastic film collection to the app
 - ii. Town changed where recyclables are received
 - 1. Used to go to Passaic County (was costing a lot)
 - 2. Now, Mazza built a single- and dual-stream recycling facility
 - a. Our recycling has been going there for a year and a half
 - b. They take #5 plastics, not just #1 and #2
 - i. This includes yogurt containers
 - ii. Change in policy should be reflected in the app*
 - c. Reduces cost for garbage tipping fees
 - 3. *Rona and John will tackle this
- c. Renewable Energy Aggregate Ordinance did you get a chance to read? Do we support?
 - i. Motion: Geoff
