RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AWARD OF PROPOSAL FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES WITH CME ASSOCIATES FOR MAIN STREET IMPROVEMENTS – PHASE I.

WHEREAS, the Borough of Bradley beach has a need to acquire professional services relative to engineering services required for the Main Street Improvements – Phase I; and

WHEREAS, CME Associates submitted a proposal dated June 6, 2024, Revised October 17, 2024, to provide engineering services relative to the Main Street Improvements – Phase I Project; and

WHEREAS, said proposal consisted of the following services and costs:

Borough Coordination and Preliminary Project Review	\$500.00
Survey and Base Map Phase Services	\$23,200.00
Preliminary Design Phase Services	\$118,300.00
Permit Phase Services	\$18,900.00
Final Design Phase Services	\$17,400.00
Preparation of Bid Documents	\$6,700.00
Bid Phase Services	\$5,000.00

WHEREAS, the Borough Mayor and Council finds it to be in the best interest of the Borough of Bradley Beach to authorize said work; and

WHEREAS, funding is available by appropriation in the budget of the Borough.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Bradley Beach, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey that the Mayor and Municipal Clerk are authorized to enter into a Contract with CME Associates as described therein.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause a notice to be published in the manner provided by law setting forth the nature, duration, service, and amount of the Contract and that the resolution and Contract are on file in the Office of the Clerk and are available for public inspection.
