**AUTHORIZING CONTRACTS WITH APPROVED STATE CONTRACT VENDORS
FOR CONTRACTING UNITS PURSUANT N.J.S.A. 40A:11-12A**

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4 et seq. (New Jersey Local Unit Pay-To- Play Laws), the Borough must award by resolution all goods and services contracts with a dollar amount between \$17,500 and \$43,999. These contracts are not bid, but vendors are still responsible to provide political contribution and company disclosure information to do business with the Borough.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4 et seq., when the cost of goods and/or services that fall between \$17,500 and the bid threshold of \$44,000 in the aggregate, an approval by resolution must be in place; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Bradley Beach retained the services of:

WHEREAS, the above-mentioned vendors completed and submitted a Business Entity Disclosure Certification.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Borough realizes that the possibility of expenditures may arise and authorize the Purchasing Agent on behalf of the Borough to issue and execute a Purchase Order for the foregoing to the above vendors with funds certified available by the Chief Financial Officer; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the CFO has been authorized to arrange to pay for the foregoing in accordance with the terms of the purchase order in the amount not to exceed of \$44,000.
