ORDINANCE 2021-27

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SCHEDULE VIII: "ALL-WAY STOP INTERSECTIONS" AND SCHEDULE VI: "THROUGH STREETS" AND SCHEDULE V: "ONE-WAY STREETS" ATTENDANT TO CHAPTER 9: "TRAFFIC" OF THE BOROUGH'S REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES TO IMPLEMENT NEW REGULATIONS ON 2ND AVENUE AND 3RD AVENUE AND A NEW STOP SIGN ON NEWARK AVENUE AND MADISON AVENUE IN THE BOROUGH

Mayor Fox offered the following Ordinance and moved its introduction:

WHEREAS, the Borough of Bradley Beach, County of Monmouth, and State of New Jersey (the "Borough") seeks to improve parking capacity, public safety, traffic flow, and resident quality of life through the construction of certain improvements and the implementation of certain new traffic regulations; and

WHEREAS, in order to implement the new traffic and parking regulations, certain amendments to the Borough's traffic and parking regulations are necessary;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Bradley Beach, County of Monmouth, and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1. "Schedule VIII" entitled "All-Way Stop Intersections" of Chapter 9: "Traffic" of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Bradley Beach is hereby supplemented with the following:

Intersection

Newark Avenue and Madison Avenue
Second Avenue and Hammond Avenue

SECTION 2. "Schedule VI" entitled "Through Streets" of Chapter 9: "Traffic" of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Bradley Beach is hereby amended as follows (~~stricken~~ text deleted; underlined text added):

Newark Avenue

a. Between Beach Avenue and Madison Avenue~~Main Street (N.J. Route 71)~~

b. Between Madison Avenue and Main Street (N.J. Route 71)

Second Avenue

~~a. Between Ocean Avenue and Third-Hammond Avenue~~

~~b. The intersection of Third Avenue and Second Avenue is hereby designated as a stop intersection. Merging traffic warnings and stop sign(s) shall be installed on Second Avenue facing westbound traffic.~~

Third Avenue

~~Between Ocean Avenue and Main Street (N.J. Route 71). A yield sign shall be installed on the easterly approach of Second Avenue.~~

SECTION 3. “Schedule V” entitled “One-Way Streets” of Chapter 9: “Traffic” of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Bradley Beach is hereby supplemented with the following:

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>Direction</u>	<u>Limits</u>
<u>Second Avenue</u>	<u>Eastbound</u>	<u>From merger with Third Avenue to Hammond Avenue</u>
<u>Third Avenue</u>	<u>Westbound</u>	<u>From Hammond Avenue to merger with Second Avenue</u>

SECTION 4. If any article, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance and they shall remain in full force and effect.


SECTION 5. In the event of any inconsistencies between the provisions of this Ordinance and any prior ordinance of the Borough, the provisions hereof shall be determined to govern. All other parts, portions and provisions of The Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Bradley Beach are hereby ratified and confirmed, except where inconsistent with the terms hereof.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall take effect upon adoption and publication in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey.
