ORDINANCE 2022-06

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 123-8: "RULES AND REGULATIONS" OF CHAPTER 123: "BEACHFRONT AREAS AND ADJACENT WATERS" OF THE BOROUGH'S REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES TO CLARIFY THAT ALL MOTORIZED OR POWERED BICYCLES ARE PROHIBITED ON THE BEACHFRONT PROMENADE.

Mayor Fox offered the following Ordinance and moved its introduction:

WHEREAS, in light of the recent rise in popularity of motorized and/or powered bicycles, the Borough of Bradley Beach (the "Borough") desires to clarify that such motorized and/or powered bicycles are prohibited at all times on the Borough's beachfront promenade for reasons of pedestrian safety;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Bradley Beach, County of Monmouth, and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 123-8 entitled "Rules and Regulations" of Chapter 123: "Beachfront and Adjacent Areas" of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Bradley Beach is hereby amended as follows (~~stricken~~ text deleted; underlined text added):


- I. *Motor vehicles and motorized/powerd bicycles*. No person or persons shall ride bicycles, skates, roller blades, skateboards, scooters, motorcycles, mopeds, and/or motor-assisted or powered bicycles, skates, roller blades, skateboards, scooters, or any other motor vehicles of any type on the promenade, or any of the public land located east of Ocean Avenue unless in an official capacity of the municipality; however, non-motorized and un-powered bicycles may be ridden on the promenade or public land between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 10:00 a.m. from May 15 through September 15. From September 16 through May 14, only non-motorized and un-powered bicycles may be ridden on the promenade at any time. This subsection does not apply to any type of motorized carts or powered wheelchairs used to assist ~~the handicapped~~ persons with disabilities.


SECTION 2. If any article, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance and they shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. In the event of any inconsistencies between the provisions of this Ordinance and any prior ordinance of the Borough, the provisions hereof shall be determined to govern. All other parts, portions and provisions of The Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Bradley Beach are hereby ratified and confirmed, except where inconsistent with the terms hereof.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon adoption and publication in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey.
